# Pre-registration

- Pre-registering must be submitted to the Branch in Grand Falls-Windsor **TWO WEEKS** prior to a scheduled clinic.
- What is required
  - Name
  - Contact information
  - Payment for the clinic
    - There are times when late registration occurs. IF it should happen , facilitators will use common sense in collecting money.

# Rationale for Two Week Pre-Registration

- It allows course conductors ample time to arrange:
  - Clinic facilities
  - Materials
  - And order clinic material from Hockey Canada's Atlantic Regional Centre

# CLINICS



- No clinics will be offered after the **February 20<sup>th</sup>** weekend .

- The course conductor will contact registered participants at least ONE week prior to the scheduled clinic to :
  - Answer any questions
  - Verify clinic location and logistics
- All logistical items will be posted on the HNL website.
- Pre-Task for the Coach Level and the Dev 1 will be available on the HNL website . Participants can download and complete prior to the scheduled clinic

# Number of Participants Required

- Associations are required to have a minimum of TEN participants for each clinic
- Should a clinic be held with less than TEN , the Association will be responsible for the cost of each “ghost “ seat.
- If there is not sufficient numbers in a region the clinic will be postponed.

# Clinic Cancellations / Rescheduling

- Minor Hockey Associations / Regions can contact NCCP / CBET Coordinator, Garry Dove to schedule or reschedule a particular clinic providing they have the minimum numbers
- Cancellations should be made 7-10 days prior to clinic date
  - This allows the facilitator to reschedule any personal activities and address issues of venue cancellations, ice times, invited guests, etc.

# HNL Required Qualifications

(Approved September 2006)

## ■ ATOM/PEEWEE/ BANTAM/MIDGET DIVISIONS

- All Coaches and Assist. Coaches MUST have *Coach level or Coach Stream (CBET)*

## ■ AAA Category Regional Representative Teams

- At least one Coach or Assist. Coach MUST have *Intermediate or Development 1*

## ■ Initiation Program

- All Coaches involved with players up to the age of 10 must be qualified through the *Initiation Program or Intro to Coach*

## ■ Hockey Canada Safety Program

- All teams MUST have at least one on-bench official qualified in the *Hockey Canada Safety Program (HCSP)*

## ■ Speak Out Program

- All on bench officials MUST have certification in the *Speak Out Program*

# Certified vs. Qualified

## ■ Certified

- Someone who has completed the course and the task book and has handed it in to the facilitator for evaluation

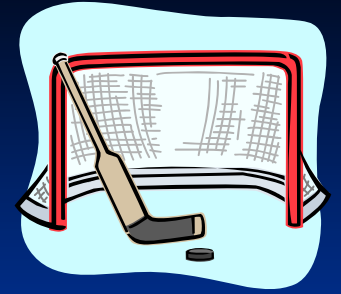
## ■ Qualified

- Someone who has attended the course but has NOT handed in any of the requested work , workbook or test.
- People should be **certified** not qualified if they want to move to the next coaching level.
