Minutes of the Fall Meeting of the HNL Female Committee held on September 6, 2014, at the Albatross Hotel, Gander, NL.

Attendance

Bonnie Evans, Chair Female Hockey; Carolyn Yates, Central Zone Coordinator, Sharon Major, Western Zone Coordinator; Sue Murphy, Eastern Zone Coordinator, Joan Hibbs, Northern Zone Coordinator, and voting delegates from Bay Arena, Bay de Verde, Bay D'Espoir, Bonavista Trinity, Botwood, CBR Minor, CeeBees, Corner Brook, Deer Lake, Fogo Island, Gander, Glovertown, Goulds, Grand Falls-Windsor, Green Bay South, Labrador West, Lake Melville, Lewisporte, Marystown, Mount Pearl, North East, Port aux Basques, St. Anthony, St. John's, Southern Shore, Springdale, Stephenville, Straits, Trinity Placentia and Twillingate/NWI. There were also 4 observers in attendance.

Call to order

At 9:06 the Chair called the meeting to order, welcomed the delegation and Ms. Yates proceeded with roll call.

AGM Minutes

The minutes from the June AGM were presented to the meeting, and a call was made for errors, omissions or business arising. There were no changes to be made and the delegate from St. John's Minor motioned to adopt, which was seconded by the delegate from CBR Minor and the Minutes were accepted as tabled.

Caroline Ouellette's High Performance Camp

The Chair advised what exactly the details on the Camp were and that Ms. Ouellette would be splitting the participants based on skill. There were 8-10 spots remaining for players, and spots were also remaining for goalies with a special goalie instructor on site. It was a very reasonably priced camp and had been well received across Canada. The Chair asked that the reps ensure all information was distributed to players and parents in their associations. It was very important that the Camp is a success to ensure we get another.

Esso Fun Day Applications

The Chair encouraged associations to apply for Esso Fun Days as it is a good introduction to hockey. To date we have 3 applications, Botwood, CBR and CeeBees. Bonavista mentioned they had applied as well and the Chair said she would check into it. This would also be a good idea for World Girls Hockey Weekend.

We Are Coaches Clinic

The Chair advised the meeting this is a zero cost clinic for associations, except providing the ice time, and the clinic could be exclusively for women and anyone at all hockey players or moms etc.. It is an intro to coaching with 1 hour of ice and 1 hour of in class time. This is not a certification just a class and the associations can join to run it with a maximum of 20 participants accepted. The last one was in 2008 and we should be taking advantage of the Clinics.

Regional Work Shops

The Regions split at 9:17 for discussions agreeing to continue in 30 minutes. Central gave their report respecting issues in the area and suggestions including: increasing the limited of underage pickups which will be discussed later; the problems of other sport coaches advising girls to pick a sport and then they cannot commit to them all; regional teams hurting their programs and probably move from 5 zones to 3; take out the requirement of D1; and that a regional association meeting get together would be good.

Hockey Development Report

Mr. Ken Chafe, Chair of Hockey Development was welcomed to the meeting and he discussed the D1 changes particularly no longer being a requirement for the U12, just Coach 2 (formerly Coach Stream) required with Hockey Canada to set a National Standard. Mr. Chafe further discussed qualifications versus certifications including Making Ethical Decisions (MED) which will now be a requirement to be certified D1. There were many questions and lots of discussions which Mr. Chafe answered or addressed.

Mr. Chafe also advised that the Development Weekend was successful and asked the delegates to encourage their coaches to attend. Regarding coach courses, the dates will be set by mid-September so please keep an eye on the HNL website. He also reiterated that there are practice plans from Day 1 to Day 200 and lots of useful information on the website to assist coaching staffs, not to mention lots of Hockey Development offers for clinics so please take advantage.

Regional Work Shop Reports continued

Northern advised the meeting they have low numbers in U20 but good in U12 and U15, maybe other associations or zones would have ideas about what to do to get numbers up; they also discussed issues surrounding coaching staffs for AAA and about All Star teams in general.

Eastern advised the meeting they had discussed if the surplus of money could be spent on provincial female program promotion; as well as discussing general issues and initiatives that they could use to bring up numbers across the board; suggested a U20 Mega should be

considered by the meeting; and that disturbances from visitors should occur on Fridays of the AGM and not during our Agenda on Saturday.

Western advised the meeting they were concerned about the Mega Tournaments happening in all divisions and forcing out small associations hosting a Provincial Tournament and keeping the levels competitive; concerns regarding ice time for U15 and restrictions that should be in place.

Referee in Chief Report

The meeting welcomed Mr. Don Kelly, HNL Referee in Chief, who took the opportunity to remind the delegates to continue trying to recruit female officials and promote getting their qualifications. Mr. Kelly had further suggestions to keep them involved and that there is lots of training available as well as opportunities such as the ACC where there were 3 spots offered and there was only 1 participant at the Officials Program of Excellence so that female official was guaranteed a spot. The Chair thanked Mr. Kelly for his comments and the meeting broke for 15 minute break.

Technical Director Visit

The meeting reconvened after the break with Paul Dagg, HNL Technical Director, dropping by the meeting and discussed offers to assist associations in putting off female skills camps including specialty camps. He discussed the launching of Hockey University and the link on the website. Mr. Dagg discussed at length a new program to assist coaching staffs and players which he was hoping would be a pilot program for Hockey NL this season. The Chair thanked Mr. Dagg.

Player Eligibility

This was the agenda item of North East delegate, Sean Bradbury, who spoke to the issue of minor hockey registered U12 girls being put off of hockey when they cannot attend invitational tournaments because they are not registered with female program. He suggested that there needs to be exposure early and exhibition games with all girls invited and eligible to play. The Chair and Mr. Bradbury discussed this at length with comments from various delegates. Mr. Bradbury felt that girls should be eligible to attend invitational tournaments if they want regardless of playing with the female program. There was no resolution or decisions made respecting this agenda item. The meeting agreed that promoting the game for U9 girls would be a great benefit to the program.

Number of Underage Pick Ups

This was the agenda item of the Lewisporte delegate, Jay Steiner, who suggests that an increase has to occur as the current limit of 4 does not allow combining of their U12 and U15 players to make a team, and even though they had 6 of each they are forced to split the girls up to other associations. The players and parents of his association want a hockey team

and it is detrimental for the smaller associations to not put a team in and for the community not to host a tournament. Mr. Steiner asked if this was an issue for other associations. There was general discussion and the meeting was advised that 3 Western Teams, 7 Central Teams and 1 Eastern Team were made up of combined associations. Eastern noted that upon combining the teams they actually lost girls. Delegates from the Straits and St. Anthony also voiced their opinions on combining teams.

Discussions ensued regarding the regions and associations and boundary issues, what constitutes an association at all if there are so few players. The delegates unanimously agreed to increase the number of pick-ups and the meeting requested that the Chair bring it to the Officers for approval. The wording would be:

"Underage pickups will be allowed from one division below, oldest players being taken first. More than 4 may be approved by the female committee if appropriate with extra consideration given if lack of flexibility will result in an association being unable to ice a female team."

President visit

The meeting welcomed President Jack Lee and there was a bit of further discussion respecting underage pickups etc., with a lunch break called for by the Chair to reconvene at 1:30.

World Girls Hockey Weekend

The Chair advised the meeting that World Girls Hockey Weekend is coming up quickly and ideas were discussed for celebrations, and the Chair reminded the delegates that it was imperative that they register their event on the Hockey Canada website. Also another request for long game sites was put forward and with strong encouragement that this weekend is a great opportunity to bring more attention to Canada and the female hockey game.

President visit continued

Mr. Lee returned to the meeting and continued with his discussions particularly on his 2 year plan of focussing on the grass roots being the foundation of the female game. He is hoping for skills camps including a female only camp with a blitz across the Province. Mr. Lee encouraged recruitment and retention of players and instructed the meeting that we need to work together so that we don't lose our girls to NS, NB, and Ontario, as 95% of the girls are playing for fun with only 5% being elite players. He stated that we owed it to the girls to give them a quality game and if we work together it will be stronger.

Regional Team Coach Selection

The Chair advised that the deadline for coaching applications was September 15 and that there had been very few applications sent to the office. Please encourage your coaches to get their applications in to the office as soon as possible as there will be no programs without coaching staffs.

Female Bantam Atlantic Championship Host

The Chair advised that Newfoundland and Labrador had to host the Bantam Atlantics being held April 2-5 and interested associations should get applications in as soon as possible.

Bantam and Midget Regional Warm up Tournaments and Play Down Sites

The Chair advised the meeting there had been no applications for warm up tournaments for either division received at the office yet. She strongly encouraged the delegates to go to their respective associations and get the ice time in place and apply for these tournaments.

Bonavista and Lab West had both applied for the Midget Play downs but again there was no application for the Bantam Play down. Again a strong request was made for hosts for the tournaments.

PeeWee Regional Teams

The Chair advised the meeting that PeeWee Regional teams would occur once the Midget and Bantam Teams were up and running and only upon sites for the warm up tournaments and play downs being secured.

Provincial Tournament Items

The Roster Deadline will be January 10 with the First Grading within a week most likely around January 18 or 19. The Chair advised the delegates the officers had instructed a goalie has to be identified on the roster and players will not be allowed to rotate into the net without any exceptions.

The U12 Mega will be held March 20-22, with the U15 Mega and U20 Provincial Tournaments held on March 27-29, there were 2 applications received from Mount Pearl and Gander for the U15 Mega. The Chair said before you apply please make sure that there are enough accommodations for teams and their families. There was a very long discussion regarding the Provincial tournaments, placements of players and teams etc.

New Business

The Chair brought forward the importance of expectations and obligations of players and teams respecting Regional Teams and adhering to same. The Chair asked that it be reiterated to the coaching staffs and each be made aware of the rules and regulations for Regional Teams particularly the commitment necessary to make it a success.

Adjournment

Motion was made by CBR and seconded by Stephenville for adjournment, and the Chair thanked all that attended and adjourned the meeting at 3:20.



2014-2015 Female Chair Report Submitted by Bonnie Evans, Chair

First of all I would like to thank everyone involved in Female Hockey for your commitment and dedication to the game. I especially want to thank the Female Committee members, Carolyn, Sharon, Sue and Joan for their assistance throughout the year. Their roles can be demanding at times and I commend them for the work they have done this past year.

The 2014-2015 hockey season was a successful season for female hockey. We had 58 teams participate in the Provincials. Under 12 Mega Tournament co-hosted by Trinity Placentia and Cee Bees, Under 15 hosted in Grand Falls-Windsor and Under 20 hosted by CBR, Gros Morne, Gander and Deer Lake.

Host sites and dates for AAA Bantam and Midget Warm-up Tournaments need to be decided early and communicated to the various teams early. The Eastern AAA Bantams had a great showing in Paradise winning Gold and Western winning Bronze. There is a great write up on the HNL website recapping the Gold Medal game. Having the game live on Aliant Webcast made it possible for thousands to view who were unable to be there. This was great promotion for the female game. I would like to thank CBR Minor and the host committee for a great job hosting the Female Bantam Atlantics. Response from the Female Chairs from the other three provinces was it was the most enjoyable Atlantic Championship they had attended. These were the same comments that came after the Midget Atlantics in Deer Lake last year. We can be proud that when Newfoundland and Labrador hosts we get such favourable comments.

I attended the Midget Atlantics in Moncton, NB with the Western team and I was certainly proud of our girls. They had tough competition but they played well and worked hard as well as being great sports.

This year during our Provincial tournaments we did a Pink in The Rink fundraiser. I attended both the Under 12 and Under 15 tournaments and I think it added to Opening Ceremonies. Girls, as well as coaches, wore pink and in so many different ways. Hats and scarves, tutu's, capes and skate laces adorned players on the ice. We had a coach who dyed his hair pink and a goalie who covered all her equipment in pink tape. I was extremely proud of the efforts of all. While the final count is not yet in it appears that \$10,000.00 was raised through the efforts of the players. The Labrador teams each raised over a \$1,000.00 each. Kudo's to everyone who participated. The local administrator for the Atlantic Breast Cancer Foundation –Atlantic Region, Paula Tessier was over-whelmed with the participation of all. I would like to see this become an annual event during our Provincials.

In closing, I would like to thank all the people who helped grow the female game during my tenure as Chair of Female over the past ten years. I have had some great experiences both at the Provincial level and the National level. At the National level I had the opportunity to attend the Women's Worlds in Ontario, the Four Nations Cup hosted in St. John's where attendance records were broke and Hockey Canada's 100 Years celebration. At the Provincial level I attended many Provincial tournaments and hung many medals around girl's necks. While not all

experiences were good, the good certainly outweighed the bad. It is difficult making tough decisions but with the various members of committees over the years, we always endeavoured to do what was best for the game and the players.

I am proud of the course the female game has taken but we still have goals to reach. We want novice, atom, pee wee, bantam and midget divisions. It can happen. When we introduced Under 15 there were associations who thought they would never form a team of just under 15 players. Now we have more associations who have two divisions and many who have three divisions. I would have liked to see this happen during my tenure as Chair but I am certain it will happen, sooner than later.

I would like to thank Tamar Hobbs and Craig Tulk for their guidance and assistance over the years. They are always professional and knowledgeable and I am certain we are fortunate to have them in our branch.

Many thanks to the Officers I have served with over the last ten years. Their support of the female game made a great difference. I owe a great deal of thanks to my husband Gerry, who made it possible for female to be as important as any other division of hockey. He was always there to support me in my role as Chair of Female Hockey and his advice and guidance was always appreciated.

I cannot thank you, the female association representatives, enough for the time and effort you give to the Female game. Without you at the grass roots there would be no female hockey. Your dedication to the program has always been recognized and appreciated. As you continue in your roles, I wish you all success at your local levels. That is where the game grows.

I will no doubt miss my involvement in the game but I am sure, without a doubt that it will continue to grow. I will always have a special place in my heart for the female program. I became involved at the local level with Mt. Pearl Minor Hockey in 1990. I have many fond memories and have made some good friends over the past 25 years. I made a very special friend in Imelda Brown whom I didn't know from Adam until we were thrown together as co-coordinators with MPMH. I have to thank MPMH for that because we connected right away and her friendship means a great deal to me.

I am so very thankful for the opportunity to have been involved with female hockey. I wish the new Chair much success in her role and will always be available to be of assistance if needed. Thank you all very much for this experience.

EASTERN ZONE COORDINATOR'S REPORT FEMALE HOCKEY NL ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ALBATROSS HOTEL - JUNE 12-13, 2015

Upon the conclusion of my term as Eastern Zone Coordinator I want to express my sincere thanks to all the folks at the 17 Eastern associations as well as my fellow Female Committee members past and present. I have learned a lot and hope I have assisted you all when needed.

In Eastern this year, there were female house league teams throughout the Zone and strong numbers were evident in all divisions. The U12 Mega Tournament had 8 teams one of which was made up of girls from 7 different Eastern Associations. Unfortunately, based on space and ice-time restrictions, there was a team that could not be accommodated, but I really hope that next season the numbers will allow addition to the grading in time to get that team into the Mega. In the U15 Mega, Eastern had 7 teams again this season which is a great indication of consistency in the numbers. In the U20 division we had more girls participate in the Provincial Tournaments, sending 6 teams from the Zone.

World Girls Ice Hockey Weekend held on October 10-12 was a great success again with different events being held in many of the Eastern associations including a Senior Women's game. Eastern saw participation grow significantly since last year and we hope that it will continue to grow over the next hockey seasons.

Multiple Invitational Tournaments were once again a source of great joy for a lot of the girls this past season and next year I look forward to more teams being able to join their competitors; as well as a greater presence of Metro Associations providing fair ice time to female hockey.

I was lucky to be able to drop into a couple of the tournaments and as usual the girl's enthusiasm was a joy to experience. The level of competitiveness was fairly even based on the closeness of the scores. There remain disparities which is most likely a result of teams having to pick up players of varied skill levels to make up a team. Thank you to the many associations that provided girls to other associations to make up teams. Female Hockey will continue with these challenges as the game grows and with hard work the registration numbers should improve.

The Provincials this year had the added initiative brought forward by our chair, Bonnie Evans, for fundraising for Breast Cancer Research and "Pink in the Rink" evolved. The Eastern Zone had 2 associations, Trinity Placentia Minor and Cee Bees Minor, join forces to host the U12 Mega Provincial Tournament. It was a great success both on and off the ice, and through the hard work of their volunteers and strong attendance from across the Province; Pink in the Rink raised \$3,684.25. CBR Minor Hockey hosted the U20A Division, with 4 teams from the Eastern Zone in very close games. In addition these teams raised \$1,023.20 for Pink in the Rink and Breast Cancer Research.

I believe that going with an U20 Mega is the way to proceed in the future. However, should the U20 Divisional Provincials continue, it was evident with the Eastern teams that as much information as possible needs to be provided to your home association and/or Female Rep to assist in proper Grading by the Female Committee. We also need more host sites for our tournaments, please go to your associations and get your voices heard.

This season ice-time seemed to be the biggest road block for Regional teams also, though the Eastern Ice Breakers did host a warm-up via Southern Shore Minor for the Bantam AAA team. Unfortunately, interest from the other zones didn't allow the Midget AAA Eastern hosted warm-up tournament to go forward.

The TriPen team hosted the Play downs via Bonavista Minor for the Midget AAA. The zone teams were very even and it was excellent hockey. I attended this tournament and it was truly great female hockey with the Western team winning the honour of representing the Province.

The Eastern IceBreakers hosted the play downs for Bantam AAA from Southern Shore Minor. The games were very competitive and the Eastern term was victorious and then proceeded to Host the Bantam AAA Atlantic Championship in Paradise. I was in attendance at all games as Hockey Canada Rep and it was an unbelievable experience. The level of play was phenomenal though there are areas, such as ice-time allocation that may need revisiting by the Female Committee and Associations on a go-forward basis. It is to be noted that the organizers had all female officials, a first for a tournament of this calibre in our Province. This is another area where associations can encourage female involvement in the game.

The PeeWee AAA program from last year was not able to secure the support from the associations necessary for ice-time allocations. I would strongly recommend that if this is a program that you want to flourish you have to have the associations behind you.

Thank you to the coaches and volunteers that gave up their time and energy to devote to the girls and to female hockey this past season.

I love hockey and particularly female ice hockey, and it was my true honour and pleasure to volunteer as Eastern Zone Coordinator. I want to say a special thank you to Bonnie Evans as a mentor for me and her patience, fairness and devotion to the game is unparalleled.

CENTRAL ZONE COORDINATOR'S REPORT FEMALE HOCKEY NL ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ALBATROSS HOTEL - JUNE 12-13, 2015

Another hockey season is now complete with rinks removing their ice surfaces and players hanging up their skates with dreams of a warm sunny summer. It has been another busy hockey year in the central region.

Central Registration

- 12 associations within the central region had female programs this season La Scie, Baie Verte, Springdale, < Green Bay South, Grand Falls-Windsor, Botwood, Bay D'Espoir, Lewisporte, Twillingate, Fogo, Gander and Glovertown.
- Registration in the central zone was up slightly this season, total 330 female players. This is great to see but we < need to continue to enhance the female programs offered in each association. Associations need to consider holding an Esso Fun Day, Bring a Friend Day, starting an U9 program or other events to help with possible enrolment. Recruiting and development is necessary to keep our female programs growing.

Regional Teams

The central region had teams in both divisions this past season - bantam and midget. Our zone has been represented at warm-up tournaments and regional playdowns since the regional format was established. The caliber of hockey displayed by our regional teams is impressive and certainly shows the progress being made in the development of the female program. Getting coaching personnel to volunteer their time to these teams proved to be an extremely big challenge this season; therefore, some tryout camps were later being conducted than wished. We need to have qualified staff personnel working with our players at this and all levels of hockey. We need to give our players the best possible guidance and encouragement while keeping the programs fun and interactive for all.

Bantam

- 26 girls (24 skaters and two goalies) tried out for the team with a roster of 15 skaters and two goalies being < selected. This was a good increase in players as last season only 17 girls tried out for the team.
- I would like to thank this year's coaching staff Darren Hanlon, Dave Dooley, Nancy Ball and Edith Hanlon for < coming on board to give these girls the opportunity to participate in the regional program.
- Grand Falls-Windsor Minor Hockey Association was the host association for the bantam team, thank you. <

Midget

- 24 players (21 skaters and three goalies) tried out for the team with a roster of 17 players (15 skaters and two < goalies) being selected.
- Thank you to the coaching staff Mark Griffin, Joe Hamlyn, Heather Griffin and Sherry Gabriel for working with < the team this season.
- Twillingate Minor Hockey Association was the host association for this team, thank you. <

One thing regional teams need to do next season is to ensure that adequate number of alternates/affiliates are named to their teams so that teams do not end up playing with short rosters at provincial playdowns and Atlantics.

Provincials

- Two associations in the central region hosted provincial tournaments this year. Grand Falls-Windsor hosted the < U15 mega tournament, while Gander hosted the U20C tournament. Thank you to these associations.
- 10 associations had a total of 16 teams participate in provincials. Botwood, Gander and Springdale had a team in < all three divisions when you consider Gander/Glovertown U12 team. Fogo iced an U20 team when they picked up Grand Falls-Windsor players. Green Bay South U20 team picked up LaScie players to make a team. Springdale U20 team joined with Baie Verte to give all the age appropriate players hockey this season. There were quite a lot of pickup forms required for provincials. Some were within their own association and some were between two neighbouring associations.

Girls World Hockey Weekend

A number of associations in central hosted Girls World Hockey Weekend events – everything from free skates, cake parties, ball hockey and mom/daughter time. Girls World Hockey Weekend is a growing event for Hockey Canada, female hockey in general and it is a great success across the country.

Travel

There was an extremely large amount of team movement this season by the various female teams within the central zone. Many teams traveled on a regular basis whether it was for one game on a weekend or to one of the many invitational tournaments hosted in the region. It was great to see so many teams working together to give everyone the game experience. Travel approval is required for all team travel.

Thank you

I would like to thank all associations, the female representatives, members of the various coaching staffs and volunteers I have worked with over the past season for their commitment to the female program. It has certainly been a pleasure to see people working together for the female program in our area and province. To the parents, thank you for your time and commitment to your children, their teams and to this great sport.

I also would like to thank Bonnie Evans, Chairperson of Female Hockey for her drive and determination over the past number of years for helping to develop the program to where it is today. She has certainly represented our province well both provincially and nationally to develop our female program. I would also like to thank the other zone coordinators for working together this past season to give as many girls as possible the opportunity to play this wonderful game.

Conclusion

The female program is growing in our region and throughout the province, which is very evident in the enrolment numbers and the calibre of hockey our players are displaying every season. With everyone working together at all levels of the female program it can only continue to strengthen and succeed. We need to continue to make hockey fun for all players as the program develops.

I have truly enjoyed working with all the players and associations over the past twelve years as your Central Zone Coordinator. I have met numerous people whose goal was to give female players a great system to play in while enhancing their hockey skills and having fun doing it. This year Churchill Falls Minor had one U-12 team that traveled to Labrador City and won the U-12 Alvin Parrell banner, they also won the U-12 banner in Goose Bay at the Steve Ramey tournament. This team also traveled to provincials and took home silver in the E division.

Lake Melville Xtreme Minor had 54 girls this year, an increase from 36 last year. They had 19 U-20, 19 U-15, and 16 U-12 players. There was a lot of interest in female hockey this year. 
