by fax to the HNL office no later than midnight on January 10. Any team failing to forward their protected list to the HNL office may be declared ineligible for further competition.	16
All players listed must be registered at the HNL office. All registered players that are	17

If you choose to protect fewer than the maximum and still have unused registrations, you may register eligible players up to the maximum allowed and they will be added to	19
this protected list at the HNL office as their registrations are received. The last date for player registration is February 10th.	20
